JUANA'S CORNHOLE TOURNAMENT RULES

MUST BE 21 OR OLDER TO PARTICIPATE

Rookie – consistently hits the board and occasionally gets it in the hole

Master – consistently gets it in the hole

Game Play

- Partner shall stand at opposite cornhole boards.
- All 8 cornhole bags begin at one end. Each team will have 4 bags of the same color. Rock/paper/scissors determines which cornhole team has honors in round one.
- The team who has honors will begin play by throwing a cornhole bag at the opposite cornhole board.
A cornhole player may throw from anywhere behind the front of the cornhole board they are throwing from.
- Alternate throws between the two opponents until all 8 cornhole bags have been thrown.
- If a cornhole bag hits the ground then bounces up onto the board, remove that bag for it does not count.
Count the points scored during the round. Continue rounds until a team has reached 21 points. The team that scores the highest amount of points on the previous round will have honors.
- Winners must report their win to the bracket holder at the bar.

Points System

- 3 points
 - Cornhole bag that goes through the hole.
- 1 point
 - cornhole bag that is on the playing surface
 - bags that are hanging on the edge but not touching the ground
 - bags that are not completely through the hole (**Masters only**)
- 2 points (**Rookie Only**)
 - Cornhole bag on the board and partially in the hole. Bag must be at least a quarter of the way in the hole to receive 2 points.
- 0 points
 - Cornhole bag that is on the playing surface, but also touching the ground.
 - Cornhole bag that is hanging off the front edge and is resting on a cornhole bag that is on the ground.
 - *If you can remove the bag on the ground without the one on the board falling then a point is given.*

"Traditional 21" Scoring

This is a negation or cancellation format where opposing players' frame points cancel one another out. Only those points that do not cancel out apply to the total overall score.

Example: Red team scores 7 points in a frame and Blue team scores 9 points in the same frame. The difference is 2 (9-7=2). Blue team scores 2 points in that frame. ***DON'T NEED TO GET 21 EXACTLY.***

Cornhole Fouls - The throw the foul occurs on is voided. If the bag is on the board remove it.

- A cornhole player's foot goes past front of the cornhole board
- A Player goes out of turn.
- Bag hits the ground before landing on the board

Double elimination brackets; one game to 21.
